PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: Knowing the power of prayer, we ask God to provide Arkansas students with wisdom and guidance in this new school year;

WHEREAS: We pray that our students embrace the opportunities created by Arkansas LEARNS, the most significant education reforms in decades, so that every child may rise above poverty and reach their full potential.;

WHEREAS: We unite with our fellow Arkansans to thank God for our great schools and the opportunities they provide; and

WHEREAS: We make a commitment to always protect the right to pray in our schools, knowing the power God holds over our state.
