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AGREED SECOND AMENDED SCHEDULING ORDER

Plaintiff Tim Griffin, in his official capacity as Attorney General of the State of Arkansas (“Plaintiff”), and Defendants TikTok Inc., TikTok Pte. Ltd., ByteDance Inc., and ByteDance Ltd., (collectively “Defendants”) (together “the Parties”) have conferred and have agreed upon this Second Amended Scheduling Order. Therefore, the following schedule will govern the case. Unless otherwise permitted with leave of court, the parties are directed to comply with the following deadlines:

Amended or Supplemental Pleadings and Motions to Add Parties	The parties shall file any amended or supplemental pleadings or motions to add parties by June 15, 2026 .
Close of Fact Discovery	No new discovery requests shall be submitted by the parties on any party or nonparty. The parties shall conduct fact discovery related to existing discovery requests so that it is completed on or before August 21, 2026 , including any party and third-party depositions (except for any fact discovery subject to a motion to compel or motion for protective order pending as of August 21, 2026). All objections related to discovery shall be in written form and filed prior to the end of

	the discovery period.
Plaintiff's Expert Disclosures	On or before August 28, 2026 , Plaintiff shall identify all expert witnesses it may call at the trial of this case and submit opening expert reports and any material required by Rule 26(b)(4).
Defendants' Expert Disclosures	On or before September 25, 2026 , Defendants shall identify all expert witnesses they may call at the trial of this case and submit expert reports and any material required by Rule 26(b)(4).
Plaintiff's Rebuttal Disclosures	On or before October 7, 2026 , Plaintiff shall identify all rebuttal expert witnesses it may call at trial and any material required by Rule 26(b)(4).
Close of Expert Discovery	The Parties shall complete expert discovery, including all expert depositions, by October 21, 2026 .
Dispositive Motions and <i>Daubert</i> Motions	Dispositive motions and briefs in support, and <i>Daubert</i> motions, must be filed by October 28, 2026 .
Oppositions to Dispositive Motions and <i>Daubert</i> Motions	Briefs in opposition to dispositive motions and <i>Daubert</i> motions must be filed by November 24, 2026 .
Replies in Support of Dispositive Motions and <i>Daubert</i> Motions	Reply briefs in support of dispositive motions and <i>Daubert</i> motions must be filed by December 11, 2026 .
Hearing on Dispositive Motions and <i>Daubert</i> Motions	December 14, 2026
Preliminary Exhibit Lists Exchanged	Parties will exchange preliminary exhibit lists on January 12, 2027 .
Motions in Limine	Motions in Limine must be filed by January 29, 2027 .
Preliminary Witness Lists	Parties will exchange preliminary witness lists on January 19, 2027 .
Oppositions to Motions in Limine	Oppositions to Motions in Limine must be filed by February 12, 2027 .
Replies in Support of Motions in Limine	Replies in Support of Motions in Limine must be filed by February 22, 2027 .

Final Pretrial Hearings	Via Zoom: February 15, 2027 In person: March 1, 2027
Parties exchange jury instructions	February 12, 2027
Final Witness Lists	Parties will exchange final witness lists on February 24, 2027.
Objections to jury instructions	February 22, 2027
Trial	March 15, 2027 – March 29, 2027

Deposition designations will be handled on a rolling basis leading up to trial. The precise schedule will be further negotiated by the parties.

Failure to comply with this Agreed Scheduling Order may result in dismissal of claims, striking of affirmative defenses, or prohibition of the introduction of testimony and exhibits.
